Applications will not be considered if postmarked or emailed later than midnight on January 21, 2018. Applications may be mailed to the council office or emailed. (See addresses at end of application)

An Eagle Scout will be selected to receive a one-time scholarship. The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000.00. Such scholarship is applicable towards tuition and other expenses at the accredited college or university of his choosing.

This application becomes the property of the Selection Committee and will not be returned to the applicant.

This scholarship is made possible through the support of the Northeast Illinois Council and the Eagle Scout Association. The applicant must have all of the following to be considered for the scholarship (incomplete/non-readable applications are removed from consideration):

- 1. Be currently registered in the Northeast Illinois Council, Boy Scouts of America.
- 2. Be currently active in a Troop, Varsity Team or Venture Crew in the Northeast Illinois Council.
- 3. Have received the Eagle Scout Award. Applicants should ensure that they have been certified (i.e approval from National) as an Eagle Scout prior to submission of the application.
- 4. Be a graduating high school senior and an entering college freshman in the year he is applying for the scholarship. The scholarship is awarded only to high school graduating seniors graduating in the calendar year in 2018.
- 5. Applicants must take the SAT or ACT in time to submit the results on the application. The ACT score printout must be submitted with application.
- 6. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities <u>outside</u> of Scouting in the school or community.
- 7. Have only one letter of endorsement from a volunteer Scout Leader who knows the applicant personally. Extra letters/resumes, etc are removed.
- 8. Attach a statement clearly stating how you adhere to the Scout Oath and Law in their daily life. (This is different than the life goals statement for the Eagle Application.) It must be signed by the Scout and a Parent/Guardian.
- 9. Typing is strongly recommended. Unreadable applications or applications with missing signatures, letters or information are removed from consideration. Please follow all instructions carefully.
