## Northeast Illinois Council, Boy Scouts of America 2019 Eagle Scout Scholarship

Applications will not be considered if postmarked or emailed later than midnight Wednesday, April 15th, 2019. Only this 2019 version of the application is accepted, any other versions will not be considered.

An Eagle Scout will be selected to receive a one-time scholarship. The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000.00. Such scholarship is applicable towards tuition and other expenses at the accredited college or university of his choosing.

This application becomes the property of the Selection Committee and will not be returned to the applicant. The Selection Committee will inform all applicants of their decision by Wednesday, May 15th, 2019.

This scholarship is made possible through the support of the Northeast Illinois Council and the Eagle Scout Association. The applicant must have all of the following to be considered for the scholarship (incomplete/non-readable applications are removed from consideration), ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE TYPED.

- o Be currently registered in the Northeast Illinois Council, Boy Scouts of America and be currently active in a Troop or Venture Crew in the Northeast Illinois Council.
- Have received the Eagle Scout Award. Applicants should ensure that they have been certified (i.e., approval from National) as an Eagle Scout prior to submission of the application. Eagle board must be dated 31 March 2019 or earlier.
- Be a graduating high school senior and an entering college freshman in the year he is applying for the scholarship. The scholarship is awarded only to high school graduating seniors graduating in the calendar year in 2019.
- o Applicants must take the SAT or ACT in time to submit the results on the application. <u>The ACT score</u> printout must be submitted with application.
- Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities <u>outside</u> of Scouting in the school or community.
- Have only one letter of endorsement from a volunteer registered Scout Leader who knows the applicant personally. Extra letters/resumes, additional pages etc. are removed. All documents must be signed where asked or application is discarded.
- Attach a statement clearly stating how you <u>adhere to the Scout Oath and Law in their daily life.</u> (This is different than the life goals statement for the Eagle Application.) It must be signed by the Scout and a Parent/Guardian.
- Typing is REQUIRED. Unreadable applications or applications with missing signatures, letters or information are removed from consideration. Please follow all instructions carefully.
