Scout Table Banner: May 1st Unit Popcorn Manager Sign Up Incentive



Units who sign up in Popcorn Manager by May 1, 2019 and sell popcorn will be eligible for a Scout table banner, useful for site sales, recruiting, parades and other events. Banners will be available at Kickoff.

Unit Delivery Incentive

Units who sold over \$15,000 in popcorn during the previous year's sale will be eligible for one free unit order popcorn delivery. This can be used during Initial Distribution or Final Distribution (recommended for Take Order Only units). Sign up at Kickoff.

\$1,500 Dave and Buster's Star Wars Battle Pod Experience



Experience the Jedi Adventure of the Star Wars Battle Pod at Dave and Busters. Scouts who sell \$1,500 can earn a Dave and Busters Power Card with 125 Chips. Chips can be used to play the Star Wars Battle Pod and other games available.



\$2,500 Train like a Jedi and Reach for the Stars at SkyZone



Experience the adventure of training like a Jedi and reach for the Stars at Sky Zone. Scouts who sell \$2,500 can earn a 120 minute all access pass to Sky Zone. Use the Freestyle Jump, Ninja Warrior Course, the **SKY ZONE** Warped Wall, and other attractions to train like a Jedi.

Trail's End College Scholarship Program: Scouts who sell \$2,500 in a single season qualify for the Trail's End Scholarship program. In addition, any Scout who has ever sold more than \$2,500 in a single season can add 6% of any amount sold in subsequent seasons.



IN EACH CASE, THE SCOUT MUST HAVE COMPLETED A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM EACH YEAR. SCHOLARSHIP FORMS ARE DUE TO THE NEIC by Friday, Over 73% goes to local Scouting December 13, 2019.
