Only this 2020 version of the application is accepted, any other versions will not be considered.

An Eagle Scout will be selected to receive a one-time scholarship. The amount of the scholarship is 1,000.00. Such scholarship is applicable towards tuition and other expenses at the accredited college or university of his choosing.

This application becomes the property of the Selection Committee and will not be returned to the applicant. The Selection Committee will inform all applicants of their decision by Wednesday, March 25th, 2020.

This scholarship is made possible through the support of the Northeast Illinois Council and the Eagle Scout Association. The applicant must have all of the following to be considered for the scholarship (incomplete/illegible applications are removed from consideration), ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE TYPED and physically signed by the Scout and a Parent/Guardian. Digital/electronic signatures will disqualify the application.

- 1. Be currently registered in the Northeast Illinois Council, Boy Scouts of America and be currently active in a Troop or Venture Crew in the Northeast Illinois Council.
- 2. Have received the Eagle Scout Award. Applicants should ensure that they have been certified (i.e. approved by National) as an Eagle Scout prior to submission of the application. Eagle Award must be approved by National on or before February, 15, 2020.
- 3. Be a graduating high school senior and an entering college freshman in the year he is applying for the scholarship. The scholarship is awarded only to high school graduating seniors graduating in the calendar year 2020.
- 4. Applicants must take the SAT or ACT in time to submit the results on the application. The SAT and/or ACT score printout must be submitted with application. Failure to do so will disqualify the application.
- 5. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities <u>outside of Scouting in</u> the school or community.
- 6. Have only one letter of endorsement from a volunteer registered Scout Leader who knows the applicant personally. Extra letters/resumes, additional pages etc. are removed. All documents must be signed where asked or application is discarded.
- 7. Attach a statement clearly stating how you adhere to the Scout Oath and Law in your daily life. (This is different than the life goals statement for the Eagle Application.) It must be physically signed by the Scout and a Parent/Guardian. Digital/electronic signatures or a lack of signatures will disqualify the application.
- 8. Typing is REQUIRED. Illegible applications or applications with missing signatures, letters or information are removed from consideration. The application must be physically signed by the Scout and a Parent/Guardian
